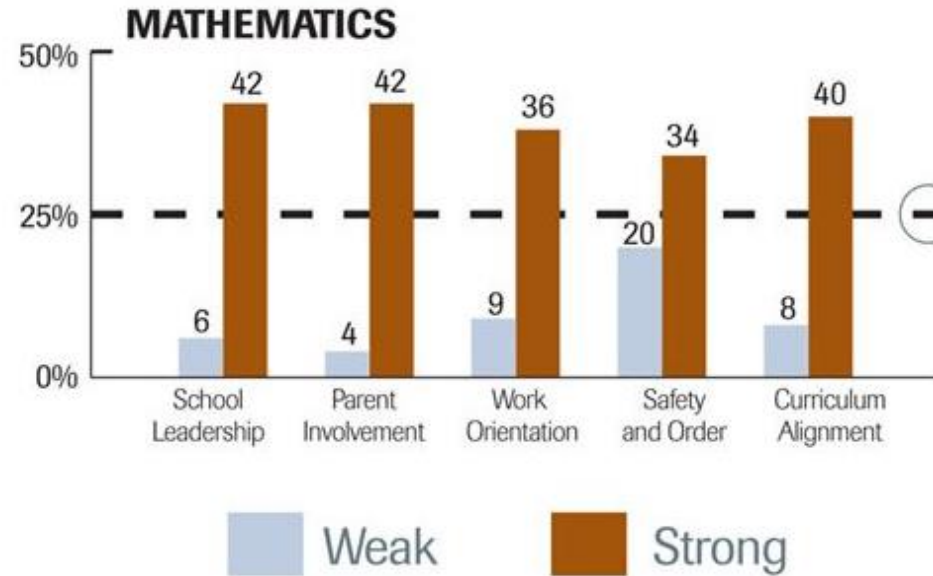

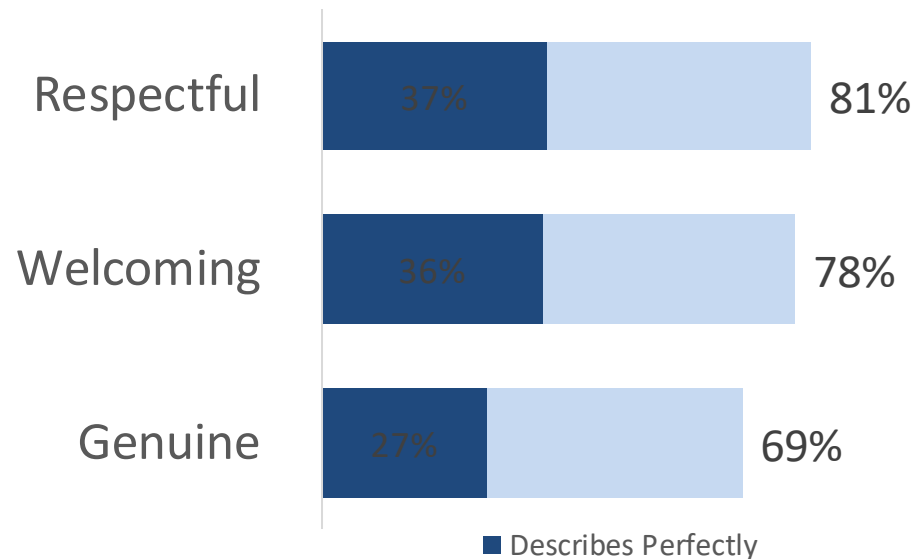
Top Takeaways

- As schools show signs of reopening, families share positive ratings of their school environment and communications.

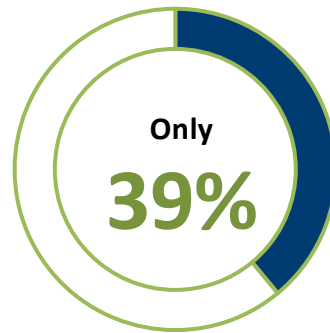

Describes How Your School **Interacts with Families**

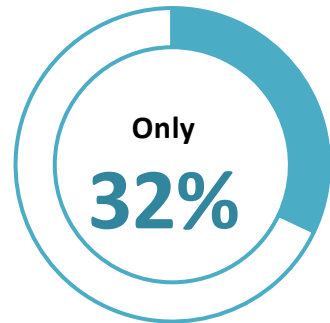

- **One area where schools can improve is communicating effectively to support student success.**

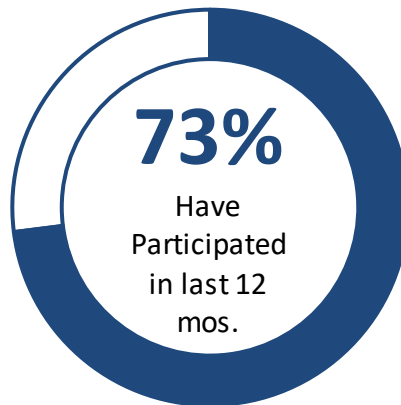
4 out of 10 parents agree...

- The teachers at my child's school **could do a better job giving parents/families honest feedback** about their children.
- My child's school **relies too much on technology like apps, texting and mass emails** to communicate with parents and families

77% of families say it would be extremely or very helpful if schools provided **families with multiple measures** on how their child is doing academically

➤ **There are simple fixes and big bets to improve effective communication for student success.**

Parent Teacher Conferences



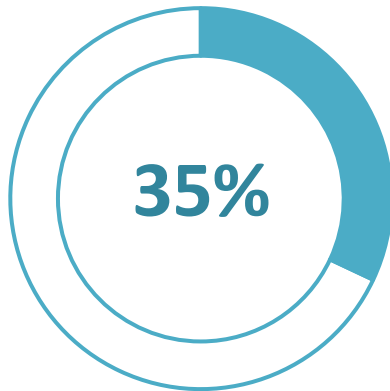

- **Strengthening how schools collaborate with families is key so they can speak up for their child and every child.**

Less than 50% of parents are very confident they **know who to ask or how to find information** they are looking for.



Of families find it **difficult to share their thoughts** with administrators.

Top priorities for more info:

- How your child's school spends its **budget**
- How add'l **funding for COVID needs** was being used at your child's school
- How your child was doing in their **social and emotional wellbeing**



Leveraging PTA's National Standards



Best Practices: School Leadership

- Communicate a positive vision for family engagement.
- Provide expectations, time, and training for educators to engage families.
- Utilize your PTA or parent organization to strengthen relationships, communication, and advocacy for all students.

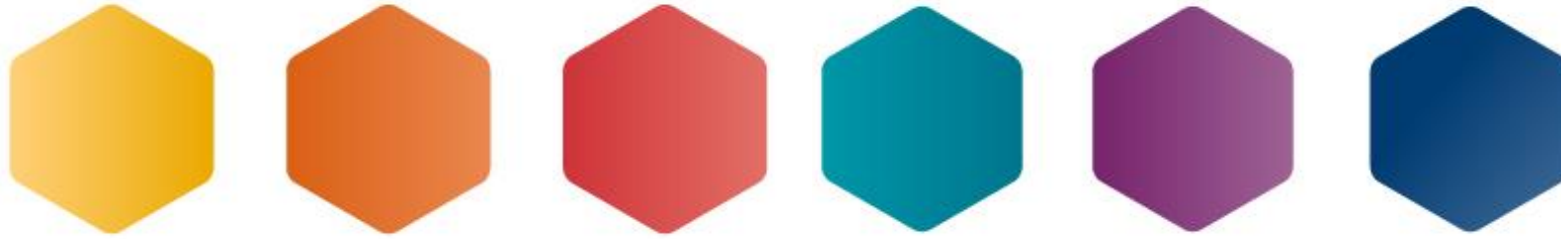
Best Practices: Influencing Your District

- Create or revise your family engagement policy to ensure it is enhancing family-school partnerships in ways that are aligned with research and best practices.
- Create a district level position (or department) responsible for family-school partnerships
- Make it clear who is responsible for engaging and supporting families

Best Practices: Board Operations

- Make meetings and documents are accessible
- Create opportunities for all constituents to provide public comment
- Ensure that advisory and governing bodies are representative of the demographics of your community

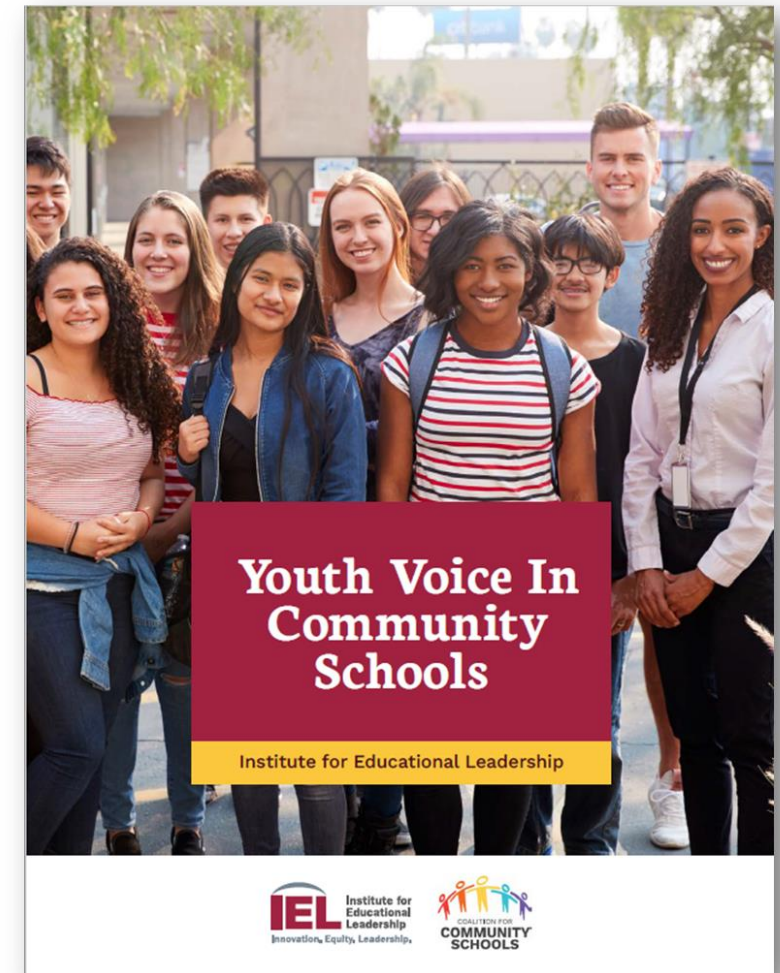
