The Community School Coordinator works collaboratively with the school principal, school support staff, community partners, and families to design, develop and/or implement Community School programming, including: family and student support services, health services, enrichment activities including those that occur during the school day, after school and summer, family and community engagement activities, and community sponsorship, partnership, and volunteer infrastructure.

The vast majority of coordinators are women.



Most Community School Coordinators hold undergraduate degrees; many also hold master's degrees.
