The FY26 Appropriations Season is wrapping up, but there are still several key steps until federal funding is decided for fiscal year 2026. The FY26 Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, and Related Agencies (Labor-HHS) bills in each chamber are at different stages in the Appropriations Process.
